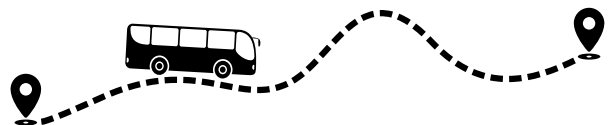

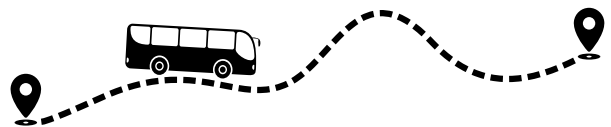

GUADALEST

In the morning we will visit this small and beautiful medieval town that is located in the center of one of the most picturesque valleys on the Costa Blanca: The Guadalest Valley. With a wonderful historical past and declared a Historical-Artistic Site and Asset of Cultural Interest, Guadalest is among the most beautiful and most visited towns in Spain.

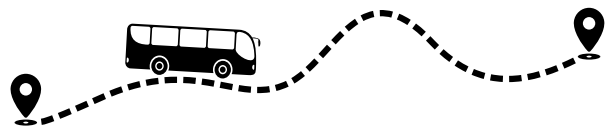




Sunday, June 30

Its origin dates back to Muslim times; It was they who fortified the town and created what is today one of the greatest attractions of the place: the Castle of San José or Castell de Guadalest. (Entry included)

Its fortress has undergone multiple changes since then, such as the one caused by the earthquake of 1644, which destroyed part of the construction. Likewise, during the 20th century it was built the Guadalest Reservoir, providing even greater beauty to the valley. After the visit and free time to enter a museum or have a drink and enjoy the place, we will go to Calpe.



CALPE

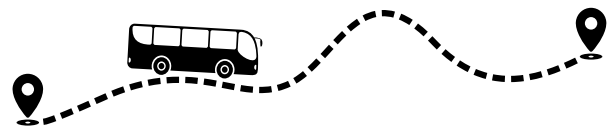
Calpe is a municipality located on the Mediterranean coast of Spain. It is famous for its beaches, such as Arenal-Bol. Not far away is the Roman site of Baños de la Reina, which includes sea pools carved in stone. On a cape to the east is the Rock of Ifach, a huge limestone formation with a great variety of birds.

After lunch we will go to visit the beautiful town.

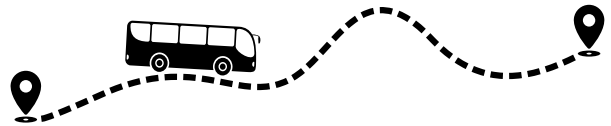
Between the sea and the mountains is a small paradise on the Costa Blanca, the beautiful destination of Altea.

If we enter its narrow, cobbled streets, we will leave aside the white houses full of colourful flowers and make way for hidden corners and viewpoints, until we reach the church Nuestra Señora del Consuelo, its square and its beautiful alleys. It has an iconic old town that breathes history marked by Muslims.

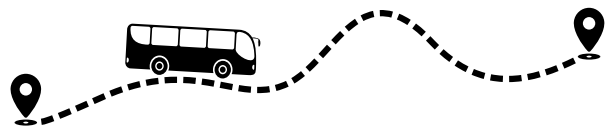

Canelobre Caves: a natural group of prehistoric caves installed in the heart of the Cabeçó d'Or mountain range (meaning Gold Head, in English). Considered to be one of the main geological treasures of the province of Alicante, the inside of these caves boasts a series of rock formations that attract thousands of tourists every year.

CANALOBRE CAVES

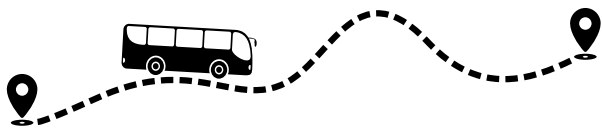
Entering Busot is like traveling back in time to the Jurassic. You do not believe it? You just have to discover the Canelobre Caves and be surprised by incredible views. These caves are one of the main attractions of the Alicante town and are a clear example of a karst cavity.

Within the Canelobre Caves there is a space of more than 80,000 square meters that can be accessed through a 45-meter tunnel in which water and rock have given rise to impressive shapes, such as stalactites, stalagmites, columns and jellyfish.

If we talk about years, this cave is more than 145 million years old. Travel inside these caves and discover all the treasures housed inside. You can find one of the highest vaults in all of Spain, with a height of 70 meters. It is as if it were the vault of a cathedral, it even has prominent elements that make a simile with the "Holy Family." We also find the Canelobre, a stalagmite in the center of the room that is more than 100,000 years old.

VILLAJOYOSA

Villajoyosa attracts attention for its warm light and its beautiful old town. I'm sure that if you visit, you'll want to come back more than once! Its small streets hide a lot of history and remind us of past times, while its houses next to the port are painted in the purest Mediterranean style. Its maritime and commercial character have determined its particular architecture. Although, without a doubt, what you cannot miss are its polychrome hanging houses over the Amadorio River. An icon of Villajoyosa!

CHOCOLATE MUSEUM

In the afternoon visit the famous and sweet CHOCOLATE MUSEUM. The Valor Chocolate Museum, created in 1998, was recognized by the Generalitat Valenciana in 2008 as the Valencian Chocolate Museum.

In its day it was the small family factory, and there you will be able to learn about the chocolate making process and the entire history of Chocolates Valor from its birth to the present, passing through the 5 generations of master chocolatiers who have run it.

In addition, it has one of the best collections of machinery in the chocolate industry from different eras, from the times when cocoa was ground on stone to the present day.

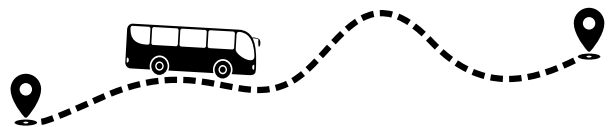

ELCHE

Elche has as many Places of interest as centuries of history, and its history dates back to the Neolithic, where the first settlers left traces of their presence. The site of current Elche was inhabited by various peoples and cultures until the 5th century BC. The Iberian city of Ilici was founded. The enigmatic sculpture of the Lady of Elche, one of the most relevant archaeological finds in our country, belongs to this culture.

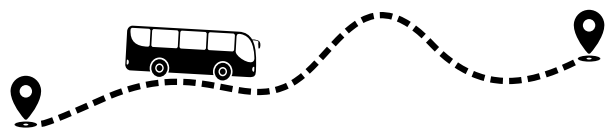




Tuesday, July 2

The Romans followed the Iberians and the Arabs, who introduced irrigation and to whom we owe the basis of what is today one of its most recognizable signs of identity: the Palmeral of Elche. This palm forest, a World Heritage Site, boasts of being the largest of its kind in Europe, although it is believed that in Arab times it must have been even larger. With more than 200,000 palm trees. We will visit the Huerto del Cura, Museum of the Palm Tree, Museum of the Festa (entrance included) Afterwards we will go to eat at a typical restaurant. MENU

Elche has also been one of the most important footwear cities in Spain.
